SUMMARY OF 2008 FOR THE GOD'S RIVER LODGE

What happened in 2008?

As we seek for peace in our hearts it is the very thoughts of the good things that transpired that will keep us focused onward toward that light at the end of the tunnel.

The awesome memories of the guests that dared to venture to God's River and the Lake without a doubt will still linger on we also remember all of those Master Angler Trophy fish that they caught. With most of the guests returning to God's River Lodge our hopes are uplifted by them.

Our additional new fleet of the 16.5 foot boats along with the 4-stroke Outboard Yamaha 40's has given our guides an edge in getting to the favorite fishing spots for our guests.

Highlighting 2008 were over 430 master anglers on our records; a combination of the Northern Pike, Walleye, Lake Trout and the Brook Trout caught during summer.

Most of the **161 Master Angler Brook Trout** caught this year were got **within** what we call the 6-Mile Limit and doesn't require an extra guide (no extra costs). What this means is that we didn't need go down to the 20 and 40-mile outcamps which has extra costs associated with them. But there were some that went there.

MASTER ANGLERS SUMMARYS

Brook Trout Summary

The largest Brook Trout was 24.5" caught on June 11 by Michael Herzog with his guide Donald Okemow. The runner up was 24" on June 13 by Charron Gilles with his guide Jeffrey Yellowback. The guest who caught the most master anglers was Mark Hertzberg with 20 Brook Trout to his name.

And the guide who is credited with 46 of the most Brook Trout Anglers caught was David Okemow.

Northern Pike Summary

The largest Northern Pike was 46.5" caught on June 30 by Hurley Blakeney with his guide Donald Okemow.

There were 4 runner ups of 46" each all on June 22 by Thomas Seaman, David O'Keale, Harry Runzel, and Thomas Burke with their guides Philip Okemow, David McKay, David Okemow and Donald Okemow.

The guest who caught the most master anglers of 34 Northern Pike was James G. Gale.

And the guide who was credited with 74 of the most Northern Pike Anglers was Barty Yellowback.

Lake Trout Summary

The largest Lake Trout was 47.5" caught on June 22 by Charlie Stablo with his guide David McKay.

The runner up was 45" on June 14 by Lester Schetrompf with his guide David Okemow.

The guest who caught the most master anglers of 5 Lake Trout was Don Hart.

And the guide who is credited with 8 of the most Lake Trout Anglers was Roderick Ross.

Walleye Summary

The 3 largest Walleye were all 29" on caught on June 11,14 & 21 by Jim Wood, Richard Baxter, Jason Corse with their guides Robbie McKay(2) and Leon Okemow.

There were 4 runner ups all 28.5" on June 14,16, 21 & 23 by Sam Busker, Scott D. Busker, Charley Stabid and Roy Kibbe with their guides Bertie James(2), David McKay & Auggie Yellowback.

The guest who caught the most master anglers was 2 Walleyes was Don Hart.

And the guide who is credited with 8 of the most Walleye Master Anglers was Barty Yellowback.

Also caught were 2 Splakes of 22" & 23" by Paul Fergeson and Josh Herzog with their guides David Okemow and Donald Okemow.

There were also 3 Whitefish Master Anglers caught on June 18, 23 & July 22 by John Dodson, Allen Stewart and David F. Lyons with their guides Barty Yellowback, Riley Ross and Jeffrey Yellowback.
